The Bridge College is partnering with Life Pacific University to offer a *Church Partnership* program for college students.

What is the Church Partnership Program?

The Church Partnership Program is an immersive training program where students earn their degree online through Life Pacific University while being mentored, trained, and discipled by the staff and pastors of a local church. The Bridge College is the partnership site based out of Life Bridge Church in Fort Wayne, IN. Students enrolled through the Church Partnership Program receive a discounted tuition rate, a higher level of care, and an opportunity to gain hands-on experience in conjunction with their education.

Schedule & Workload

Partnership students take a full class schedue, roughly 15 credits per semester. Additionally, they serve along-side their fellow TBC students at Life Bridge Church in ministry rotations, attend weekly chapels, developmental courses, team lunches, and various other meetings and obligations. Below is the estimated weekly workload breakdown:

Study Time: 10 - 15 hours Personal Development: 4 - 5 hours

Serving: 2 - 3 hours

Personal Time: 6 - 10 hours Work / Employment: 15 - 20 hours
